

Green class is exploring the topic of Transport this half term. They are learning about the history of transport in Discovery; they went back in time to see how the trains were invented and created a timeline of how the train has evolved. They have looked at the railway lines in the UK and where they could go by train. In Design and Technology pupils have learned about axles and how they are made to move. They also worked together to create their own small world that connects through different modes of transport, they had a motorway, harbour, train station and roads, railways and rivers connecting each place. In Science pupils are learning about states of matter; they have melted chocolate and then cooled it again, mixed corn flour and water together to create a substance that changes from solid to liquid and they have represented particles by drawing them and using objects to show what the particles look like in each state. In PSHE pupils are developing skills in managing feelings and reflecting on the Zones of Regulation. They have also been enjoying PE on Fridays with coach Ollie, learning and developing movement through games and taught skills. In computing they are learning about programming and have worked with the BeeBots and using ScratchJr on the iPads. They have absolutely loved their pet therapy sessions with Hope, the dog!
