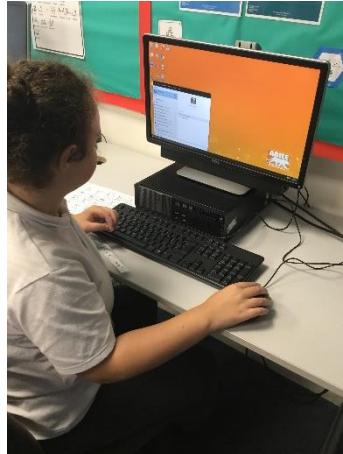


Red Class
