What an exciting month May has been! As well as continuing with our Under the Sea topic, we celebrated the King's Coronation with several days of activities and had a chance to do some Maypole dancing!

In Maths, we have been exploring repeating patterns by recognising and continuing a range of patterns and talking about the repeating part. We have also been working on our understanding of subtraction using real objects and number lines.

We have been developing our speaking and listening skills in English by taking part in role play. We used the outdoor classroom as our stage and each played a character from "Room on the Broom". We acted out the story and said the lines for each character – some of us were very dramatic!

In Music, we have explored orchestral instruments through the story and music of Peter and the Wolf by Prokofiev. We all enjoyed the story and listened carefully to the tunes played by the different instruments so that we could recognise the characters they represent. We had fun playing the kettle drum and having a go at playing the violin and flute.

We had a visit from the Farm earlier this month and the children thoroughly enjoyed feeding and petting the guinea pigs, rabbits, chicken and duck!

In Science we have been learning about micro-habitats and looking at where mini beasts live. We went into the sensory garden and lifted logs to explore their home. We used magnifying glasses and dishes to observe these creatures and talked about the conditions of their habitat.

Pupils have made excellent progress in PE playing cricket. They have all showed good control when directing the ball and have all experienced bowling and batting. We played a whole class game of cricket where pupils worked in two teams. Everyone joined in!
