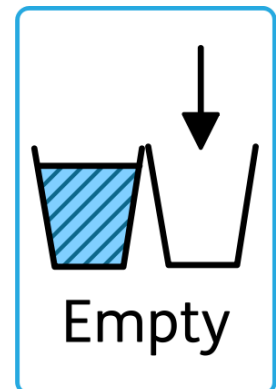
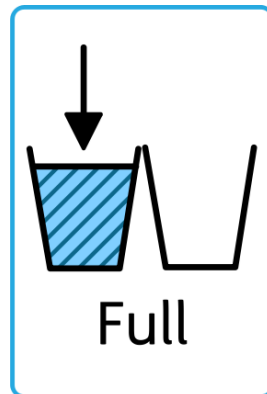

In food tech we then had to follow the design to make our pizza the same. Also, in English we have been looking at fact files for non-fiction text. As our topic is the seaside we looked at facts about the seaside. We had to find the correct symbol which showed the right fact and stick it on.
