

Yellow Class

These past couple of weeks have already been so busy in Yellow class diving straight into our 'Under the Sea' topic!

Pupils have enjoyed exploring animal habitats in Science learning about the different features of living things and sorting animals into their correct animal groups.

We are learning about the 5 oceans of the world in Discovery and have looked at world maps and a globe to see how water and land are represented. We worked together to find where each ocean is and are trying to remember some of the names – Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Southern and Arctic.

In PE we are lucky enough to have a cricket coach teaching us the fundamental skills needed in order to play a game of cricket. Pupils have engaged really well with the different roles involved in the game and everyone has worked well in their teams.

In Cooking we have been focusing on the skill of boiling using the hob. Pupils have been brilliant at turning on the hob safely and all experienced boiling an egg! We have had a couple of exploding eggs, when they have been peeled but overall everyone has done a cracking job!

In Creativity we have been learning about the work of Japanese artist Yusei Nagashima and have explored his love for painting fish using water colours. Pupils replicated his work using water colours and did a fantastic job at observing the details of tones of the colours used.

In Maths, we have been working on subtraction using practical resources to take away one amount from another. We have also been developing our understanding of capacity and had great fun filling, half filling and emptying containers using sand and water!
