

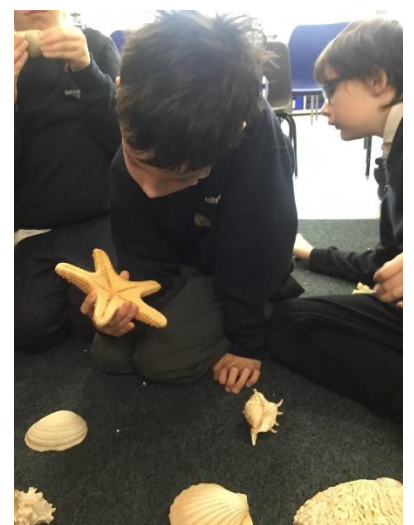
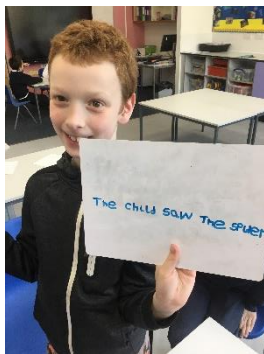
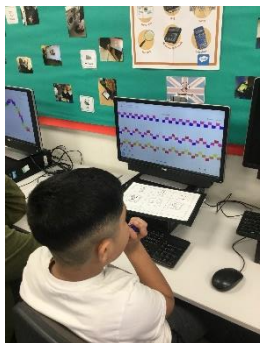


Welcome to the summer term! Our topic this half term is –
Under the Sea 🐠

Green class enjoyed their trip to Gilbert White Field Studies Centre. They explored the grounds and learned a bit about the different vegetables that are growing in the garden. They met a tree and measured it, took leaf rubbings and discovered small creatures living in the tree. They also searched for the small creatures in the wood piles, sat and watched birds in the bird hide and finished the day with a story about what Gilbert planted in his garden and why he did this – special plants that all his favourite animals liked.

This half term pupils will be exploring oceans and seas. In Science they will learn about the habitats in oceans and look at materials that float and sink. In Discovery they will be learning about the 5 oceans and the seas around the UK. They will be learning about poetry in English, this past week they have read limericks and are learning to identify rhyming words. In Mathematics they are learning about capacity and measurement. In Computing they are exploring music and sound using ICT. They are currently working on song maker - chrome music lab.

PE this term is extra special as we have coach in to teach the pupils bat and ball skills and how to play cricket.
